

# Lone Star Storytellers Audition FAQs - 2018

# What will Lone Star Storytellers do?

Lone Star Storytellers (ages 9-18) learn, craft, and perfect a five minute spoken story. They perform these stories at various venues throughout Frisco, culminating in performances at the Lone Star Storytelling Festival on Oct. 11-13, 2018. Lone Star Storytellers share the stage with professional storytellers and may be selected to perform for thousands of students during FISD Field Trips to Dr. Pepper Arena.

# What are the benefits to becoming a Lone Star Storyteller?

- Develop public speaking skills and build confidence.
- Become part of a professional storytelling troupe and contribute to the Frisco arts community.
- Showcase your talent through performances in the Frisco community.

### What is the program curriculum for students?

- Attend (with a guardian) orientation on Wednesday, August 8 from 3-4pm or 7-8:00pm (mandatory for new students).
- Complete at least seven free, one-hour coaching sessions provided by storytelling professionals on staff at the Frisco Public Library and from the Frisco community.
- Perform at one community concert held at various venues throughout Frisco.
- Perform before family and friends at mandatory dress rehearsal Monday, October 8, 2018 from 6:30-7:30 pm.
- May be selected to perform during FISD's Field Trip Days Thursday or Friday morning, October 11-12 or...
- Perform during the Festival on Friday and/or Saturday, October 12-13, 2018.

# How are Lone Star Storytellers selected?

Auditions will be judged by a panel of storytelling professionals assembled by the Frisco Public Library.

#### What needs to be on the audition DVD or YouTube performance?

- Record the student telling a memorized story of his or her choice no reading from books or scripts please.
   Students may not use DVD performances from previous years' festivals.
- The audition story should be no more than five minutes long. Please do not record the audition outdoors.
- Make sure student states their full name and the name of the story at the beginning of the audition.
- Write the student's name on the actual DVD with a black Sharpie.
- If selected, the student may be approved to tell the same story at the Festival that they auditioned with or may be asked to select a new story. All stories chosen for the Festival must be approved by coaches.
- Auditions must be recorded on a PC formatted CD or a DVD that can be played in a DVD player. Students may
  also upload the audition to YouTube. YouTube links may be emailed directly to <a href="mailto:bbarber@friscotexas.gov">bbarber@friscotexas.gov</a>.

#### How do I submit an audition?

- Pick up a Lone Star Storyteller audition form and FAQ sheet at the Frisco Public Library's 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, the 1<sup>st</sup> floor Teen room or at <a href="https://www.lonestarstories.org/auditions">www.lonestarstories.org/auditions</a>.
- Submit both the audition video and a completed audition application form to <a href="mailto:bbarber@friscotexas.gov">bbarber@friscotexas.gov</a> or to the Frisco Public Library during the Library's regular hours (Monday –Thursday, 9am-9pm; Friday, 9am-6pm; Saturday, 10am-6pm; Sunday 1pm-6pm) between **March 1 and May 1, 2018.**

#### What is the audition deadline? When will I know results?

Deadline is May 1, 2018 at 9:00pm. All auditionees will be contacted via email by May 25, 2018.
